I am AGAINST the following:

- Lift restrictions on telecommunications common carriers with a 10-percent market share or less, by revenue; or
- Remove telecommunications restrictions completely.

Removal of restrictions to foreign investments in telecommunications will go against what we believe to have, a democratic system. We should continue with Public Consultation practices to consider what matters to the public in a given time and place. Also, continue to involve regulatory and other government measures.

While improving services for consumers; advancing in technology; and strengthening the market competitiveness, Canadian residents should not become affected or feel threatened by interconnected matters such as health hazards and negative effects on property value. Since evolving technology is an unknown field, it should be treated with caution. There should be consistent periodic re-evaluation and investigation and periodic reports should be made public.

On the one hand, we might be making a lot of money for a short period of time; and on the other hand, we would have to spend double or triple amounts to repair damages or in compensation.
