Re: Gazette Notice No. DGRB-010-07 – Consultation on Proposed Conditions of Licence to Mandate Roaming and Antenna Tower and Site Sharing and to Prohibit Exclusive Site Agreements (the Consultation).

Rogers Communications Inc. (Rogers) is in receipt of a letter from Bell Mobility (Bell) to the Department, dated January 15, 2008. In its letter, Bell has requested that the Department include a reply comment round in the process established for the above noted consultation.

Bell's request arises from the fact that the Consultation addresses matters of considerable complexity, that the resulting decisions will have impacts on many aspects of Bell Mobility's operations, and that the decisions arising from the Consultation will permanently affect the Canadian wireless industry.

Rogers concurs with Bell and we would add that the resulting decisions will also impact Rogers' wireless operations. Rogers believes that the process employed by the Department should provide for a testing of the soundness, suitability and practicality of the initial comments of parties.
