## Subject: Displacement of 2.5 GHz MCS System

As you are aware, on March 22, 2000 Minister John Manley announced the results of the comparative licensing process to provide Multipoint Communications Systems (MCS) services in the 2500 MHz band for areas across Canada. Sask Tel was awarded a licence to serve the province of Saskatchewan, and Inukshuk was awarded 12 licences to serve the remaining areas except the province of Manitoba.

In conjunction with the above announcement, Jan Skora, Director General, Radiocommunications and Broadcasting Branch advised you in a letter of the same date that the Department was unable to accommodate your request for grandfathering your MCS system operating in Toronto.

Therefore, in accordance with the 2.5 GHz MCS licensing policy entitled "2500 MHz Multipoint Communication System Policy and Licensing Procedures", you are hereby given notice that as an incumbent licensee in this band you must cease to operate this MCS system within two years from the date of this letter.
