TRADEMARK FOR CANADIAN ESKIMO CARVINGS

by John de Bondt and Bill Larmour



If you are looking for authentic Eskimo art, it's going to be harder to fool you. Canada's Eskimo artists now have a trademark.

They wanted a symbol to identify their work, for its success brought imitations. To know the real from the imitation, their rule is simple: don't buy an Eskimo carving without the authorized seal attached.

The newly approved emblem depicts an igloo — the Eskimo's traditional form of shelter and protection — and the words "Canadian Eskimo Art". It is designed to distinguish the Canadian Eskimos' original form of art from foreign imports and mass-produced imitations. It is also designed to protect the Eskimos from any individuals who might try to exploit them and sell their work by doubtful means. Only pieces properly bought and paid for will carry the certification mark.

The trademark appears in two forms: as a sticker and as a string tag. The tag also has

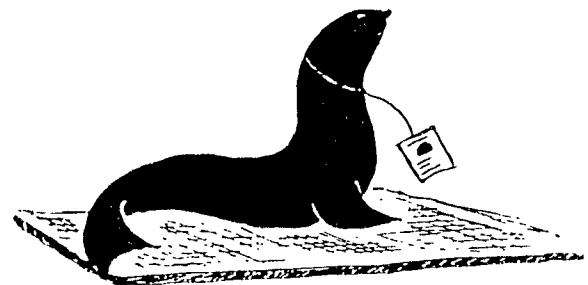
space for the carver's name, the place of origin and the price. Both stickers and labels are applied to the carving at the point of origin.

The symbol was designed on Eskimo themes by Ottawa artist James Boyd. It was registered by the Department of Northern Affairs in the name of "Her Majesty the Queen in the right of Canada" and covers "carvings made by Eskimos of Canada, principally in stone and ivory". The purpose of the registration mark is to establish the authenticity of the origin of the carvings, not to serve as judgment on the artistic merits of any particular piece.

The registration followed requests for the right to copy Eskimo carvings for mass production, and the appearance on the Canadian market of work by foreign imitators. Unfortunately, some Canadian customers have been duped into buying pieces incorrectly represented as the work of artists from Arctic Canada. The new registration mark is designed to protect both artist and customer.

Canadian Eskimo carvings are made at isolated communities scattered throughout the Arctic. The known revenue to the Eskimos was more than \$100,000 last year.

So, if you are buying, remember the advice of the Eskimo (whatever the seller says): "If there is no registration mark, it may not be authentic".



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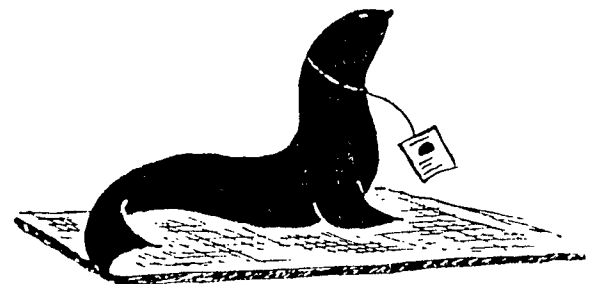
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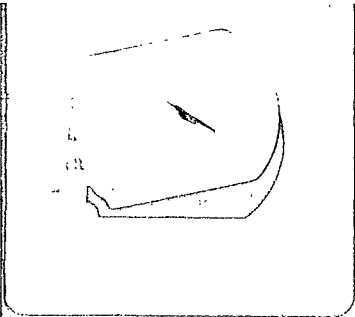
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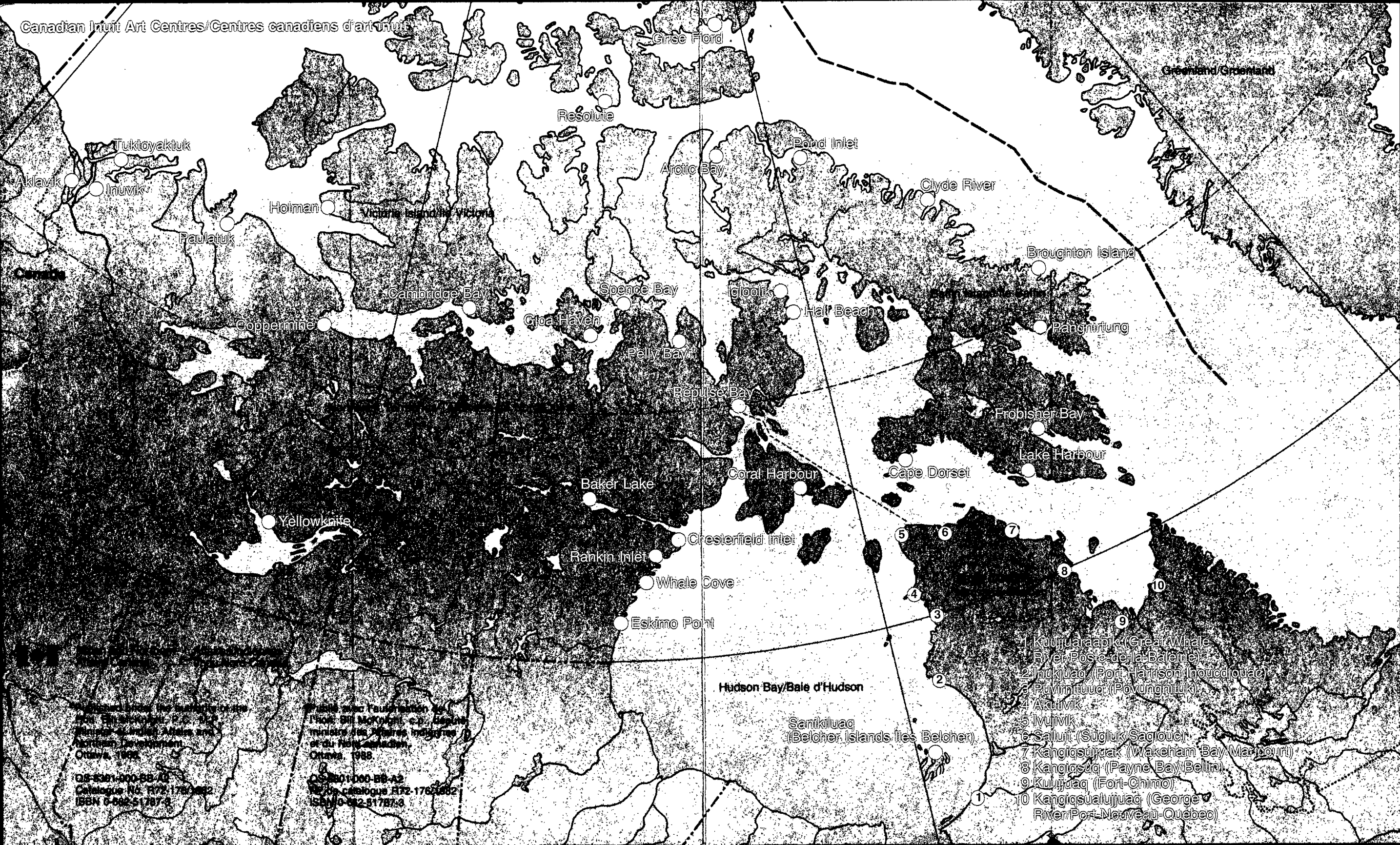

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Carvings from Arctic Canada

Sculptures de l'Arctique canadien



The Inuit, also known as Eskimos, depended for their very survival on the ability to make with their hands all the necessities of everyday existence. This manual dexterity extended to the making of carved objects for decoration, magical or religious rituals, toys, and, later, for trade. Over the past thirty years, people have shown an increasing interest in Inuit art and culture. This has encouraged Inuit across the Arctic to begin producing in quantity carvings representative of their traditional camp life.

The carvers reveal individual preferences for both subject matter and material. One may draw subjects primarily from hunting and animals, while another may turn to the world of spirits or the igloo home. Stone is the most frequently used material, but antler, bone, and ivory are also worked by Inuit carvers. As the artists have settled in permanent communities, carving has become an important means of expressing their memories of the traditional Inuit way of life.

Inuit sculpture is now recognized around the world. Because it is a sought-after and uniquely Canadian form of artistic expression, it has led to a proliferation of mass-produced imitations. To protect the consumer and Inuit carvers, the Canadian government has registered the symbol of the igloo as a trademark. Carvings bearing this "igloo" tag or sticker are certified to be hand-made by Inuit.

Les Inuit (Esquimaux) devaient pour subsister, fabriquer à la main tout ce qu'il leur fallait pour la vie quotidienne. 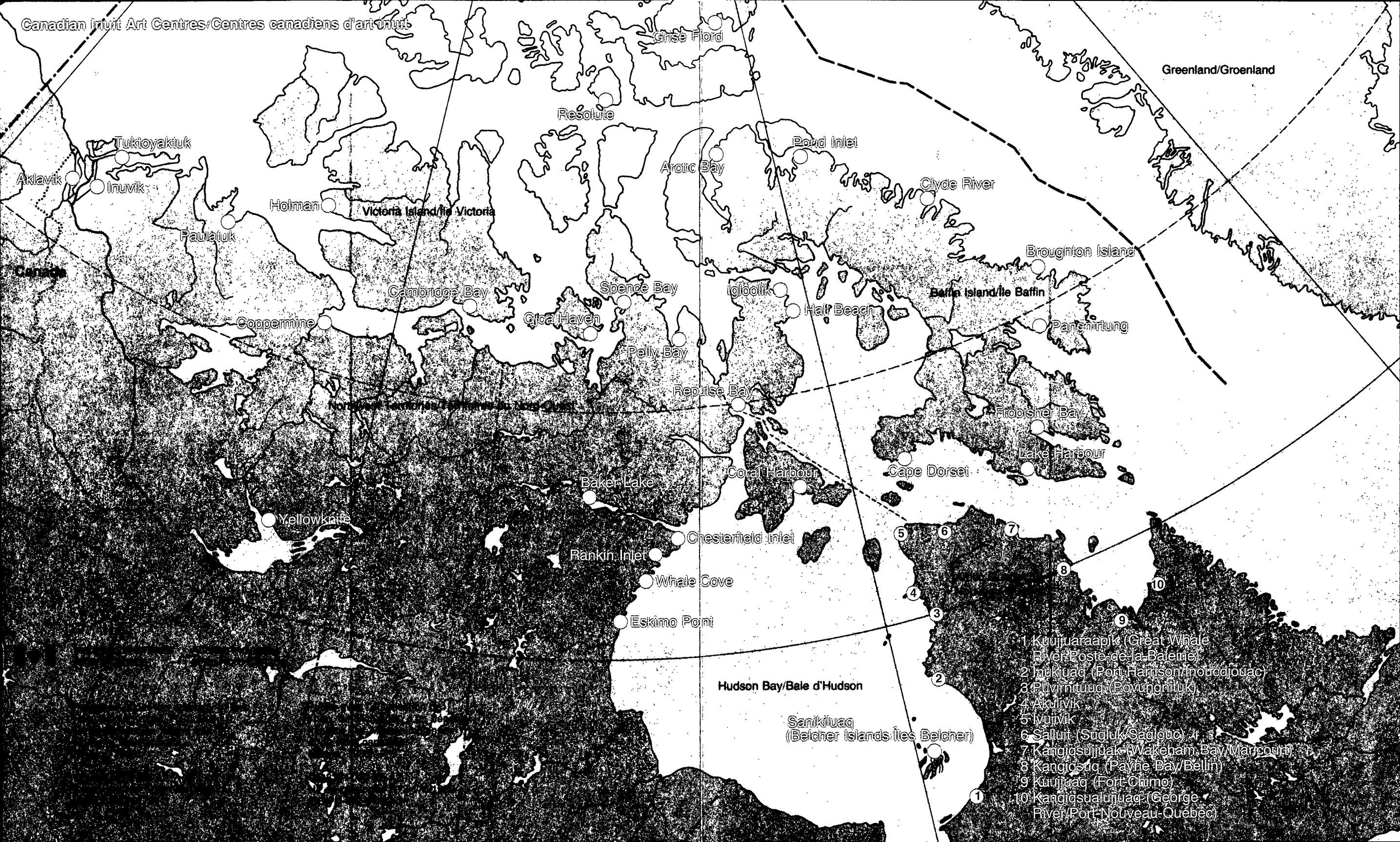
Chaque artiste a un sujet et une matière préférée. Tandis que celui-ci représente les animaux, la chasse, un autre préfère les êtres mystiques ou légendaires. Les sculpteurs emploient surtout la stéatite mais se servent aussi d'ivoire, d'andouiller, et d'os de baleine. Maintenant que les Inuits demeurent dans des communautés permanentes, la sculpture est devenue pour eux un moyen important d'exprimer et de conserver leur patrimoine culturel.

La sculpture inuite est maintenant reconnue à travers le monde. Parce qu'il s'agit d'une expression artistique uniquement canadienne et très recherchée, il y a une prolifération d'imitations fabriquées à la machine.
