**Radio Advisory Board of Canada
Preliminary Response to DGTP-008-04, *Gazetted* 2004-10-02
Revisions to Spectrum Utilization Policies in the 3-30 GHz Frequency Range and
Further Consultation**

The Radio Advisory Board of Canada's Fixed Wireless Communications Committee commends the Department for the timely release of this consultation.

The Committee, on behalf of the Board, takes note of the various decisions, having had ample opportunity to discuss them in other fora, especially in RABC committee meetings. With specific regard to the consequential changes to the Canadian Table of Frequency Allocations:

4.940-4.990GHz - The RABC supports this change which was encouraged by the RABC in an earlier consultation. Applications in line with these changes are being developed and we look forward to assisting the Department in its further considerations of this band in the very near future.

With regard to the *Provisional Changes*:

- **13.75-14.00 GHz** – The RABC supports this change;
- **19.3-19.7 GHz** – the Board supports this change; and
- **29.1-29.25 GHz** – the RABC supports this change.

With regard to the footnotes CYY and CZZ proposed in Section 7: the Board has reviewed these and supports the changes.

The Board will submit a balloted response covering the *Further Consultation* items.
